Fellowships are prestigious one-year (first year of graduate school) awards offered to the best students admitted into Ohio State's graduate programs. Fellowships are not awarded by the Fisher College of Business - instead, they are awarded by the university's Graduate School via a university-wide competition. If nominated, you will be competing against admitted graduate students from both Masters and Ph.D. programs across the university. Fisher automatically evaluates each person admitted for merit-based funding, including Fellowship nomination consideration.

## UNIVERSITY FELLOWSHIP

University Fellowships are used to recruit new graduate students to The Ohio State University. The University Fellowship nomination doesn't require U.S. citizenship or have a diversity requirement; however, your unique story is an important component. Think about how you can highlight yourself beyond excellent grades and outstanding test scores. Your application will be reviewed next to a wide range of majors and personal backgrounds.

### Who is considered for nomination?

- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.6 at the time of application (3.8+ strongly recommended) *and*
- Score in the top quartile (25%) on the GMAT or GRE *and*
- It is not just grades and scores. You must be able to showcase yourself and stand out.

### Tips from Fisher's admissions team

Along with your essay and detailed resume, you must submit at least **three** letters of recommendation as part of your application to a Fisher graduate program. ## GRADUATE ENRICHMENT FELLOWSHIP

Graduate Enrichment Fellowships are used to recruit graduate students who bring diversity to The Ohio State University Graduate School. The Graduate School considers "diversity" to be a broadly defined concept. Features of an applicant's file that could satisfy this criterion include, but are not limited to, ethnic background, social or economic disadvantage, nominee status as a McNair Scholar, disability, or other characteristics or attributes.

### Who is considered for nomination?

- U.S. Citizenship required *and*
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.2 at the time of application (3.3+ strongly recommended) *and*
- Score in the top half (50%) on the GMAT or GRE *and*
- Contribute to the diversity of the graduate school
